



Notice of Race Berger and Stein Races #4 & #5 and SMWYC - Mac Jones Series

**Catalina Layover & Return Races
Saturday, June 12, Sunday June 13, 2010**

Rules: These races shall be governed by the “*rules*” as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). These races are part of a series, which is described in this separate Notice of Race.

The Mac Jones Series is sponsored by Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club. You are automatically entered in this series when entered in the Berger/Stein Races. We are pleased to have SMWYC as a co-host of these races.

Safety Equipment: All boats (**including Stein classes**) will be required to comply with the requirements for a SoCal PHRF **Category 3** race. All PHRF and Cruisers must comply with these rules. Also, on boats without lifelines, competitors will be required to wear a PFD when racing (unless when changing clothing).

Eligibility and Entry: all boats shall comply with the eligibility and entry requirements set forth in the **Notice of Series** for the Berger and Stein Series.

Entry Fees - The entry fees are computed as follows:

\$20.00 per race (race 4 and race 5) - US Sailing Members – Early Entrant Rate

\$25 per race - Non-US Sailing Members – Early Entrant Rate

\$30 per race - Regular Rate

(Early Entrants are those that enter by Wednesday, June 9th, before the race.)

\$20 - Add Late Entry Penalty (after 5pm on the Friday before the Race).

\$10 - Add Beverage Fee for Race 4 (for free Beer and Sodas and cook your own food on the hot BBQs at Cat Harbor). **This \$10 needs to be added to all Series Rates** as indicated above.

Notice to Competitors: Any changes to this Notice of Race or the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the bulletin board on the right hallway inside the main entrance of the DRYC clubhouse. Notices available before race day will also be posted on the DRYC website (www.dryc.org).

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be made available on-line on the DRYC website and at the club at least two days prior to race #4.

Classes: Final Classes and order of starts will be announced as described in the Sailing Instructions.

Cruising Class Mandatory Skipper's Meeting: Skippers of boats entered in Stein #4 & #5 are required to attend the Skipper's Meeting at 0900 at DRYC on the day of race #4 (Saturday).

Saturday (Berger #4 and Stein #4)

Starting Time and Location: The Warning Signal for the first Berger class is scheduled for **1055**. The Stein classes will start after the Berger classes. The starting line on Saturday will be in the vicinity of MDR "H" Mark, which is a yellow spar, approximately 0.6 NM at a heading of 235° from the middle of the Marina del Rey breakwater.

Courses: The course for the **Berger** classes will be to Catalina Harbor, leaving the "West End" of Catalina Island to port. This course will be approximately 35-37 NM.

The course for the **Stein** classes will end at a pre-determined GPS "Finishing Point" off of the West End of Catalina, the Lat/Long of which will be given in the Sailing Instructions. Boats in the **Stein classes MUST have a working GPS on board.**

They will be required to "self-finish" and report their finish times via VHF. This course will be Approximately 28-30 NM.

Sunday (Berger #5 and Stein #5)

Starting Time and Location: The Warning Signal for the first Berger class is scheduled for 1155. The Stein classes will start after the Berger classes. The starting line on Sunday will be in the vicinity of "Eagle Rock," approximately 1 mile south of the "West End" of Catalina Island.

Course: The course will be to the vicinity of the South entrance to the Marina del Rey Harbor. This course will be approximately 29-31 NM.

Hospitality: There will be coffee and bagels available at both the Skipper's meeting on Saturday at DRYC, and Sunday morning at Cat Harbor. After racing on Saturday, there will be our famous **Margarita Bar** along with free beer and sodas. And, you get to cook your own food on our hot BBQ Grills. Sunday there will be normal bar service at DRYC after the races. (see Trophies below)

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded after the race to Cat Harbor for race 4. For race 5, the trophy presentation for this race, and the overall Berger/ Stein Series trophies will be awarded at the Sundown Series BBQ on **Friday June 18**. Up to 3 trophies will be awarded for each class.
