**Squirrel Bank Race**  
**Saturday March 1, 2014**  
**Notice of Race**

Del Rey Yacht Club cordially invites **PHRF, ORCA** and **Cruising** class boats to race in the Squirrel Bank Race. This is the race to Santa Monica Bay Wave rider Buoy 028 (10.5 miles southwest of the Marina Del Rey Harbor) and back.

**RULES:** This race shall be governed by the “*rules*” as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

The So Cal PHRF Marine Industry Racer (MIR) rule will not apply to this race. However, individuals who meet the definition of a MIR under the So Cal PHRF Class Rules will not be allowed to steer a Cruising class boat.

**ELIGIBILITY:** This event is open to PHRF, OD, ORCA and Cruising class boats. This is a PHRF so Cal Cat 3 event. All keel boats must comply with So Cal PHRF cat 3.

**ENTRIES:** Entries must be made on line at Regatta Network no later than 1700 on Friday, February 28. Late entries will NOT be accepted. On line registration details at [www.dryc.org](http://www.dryc.org).

The entry fee is \$30 (\$25 for members of US Sailing). Payment may be made online or delivered to the DRYC front desk or Race Committee no later than one hour after finishing the race *regardless of whether you pay online or later at DRYC*.

**STEIN ENTRANTS PLEASE NOTE:** If you entered Stein 1 there is no need to fill out the cruisers handicap adjustment form. Your rating is set for the series. If you change the sailing/racing configuration of your boat then you must submit the cruiser handicap form no later than the Wednesday before the race and your boat will be re-rated and entered as a new entry for the series. Rating work sheets are available at DRYC. All boats must race in the configuration upon which their handicap is based. THERE WILL BE NO SKIPPERS MEETING.

**NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:** Notices to competitors will be posted by 0900 on race day on the bulletin board on the right hallway inside the main entrance of the DRYC clubhouse (Notice Board). In addition, Notices will be posted on the DRYC website ([www.dryc.org](http://www.dryc.org)), which may not be possible for Notices made on race day.

**SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Sailing instructions will be available online on the DRYC website and at the DRYC front desk at least two days prior to the race. The race committee may attempt to e-mail the SI, order of starts and any other documents prior to race day.

**CLASSES:** That information plus the Order of Starts will be posted no later than 1800 on the day before the race.

**SCHEDULE:** The starting line will be in the vicinity north of the detached Breakwater off the Venice Pier. The first warning for the first class will be scheduled for 1155.

**COURSE:** The course will be to Santa Monica Bay Wave rider Buoy 028 (9.7 +/- miles southwest of the start line) and back. The course distance will be approximately 20-22 nm.

**HANDICAPS:** For PHRF classes, RLC Ratings for Area B1 will be used. For ORCA classes, ORCA ratings will be used. For Cruising classes, handicap ratings are based on PHRF RLC rating, the DRYC Cruiser Handicap system and are assigned by the DRYC Cruising Chair.

**TROPHIES:** Trophies for this race will be awarded at DRYC after the race based on 3 per class

**CLUB FACILITIES:** All participants are invited to the after race buffet and trophy presentation, and are invited to use the dining room and bar. Dining room closes at 1800

**SLIP RESERVATIONS:** Limited docking will be available at DRYC. Reservations are required in advance and should be made by calling the DRYC Office at **310-823-4664**.
